2. **Prepare Your Cat:** All cats **MUST** arrive on time and in a **SECURE** carrier. Cats not arriving in a secure carrier will not be accepted.
3. **Arrive on Time:** Drop off your cat at PetMed Animal Health Center at your designated time and pick up at your designated time.

Additional Information:

- **Eligibility:** This event is specifically for stray and feral cats. If you have a pet cat that needs spaying or neutering, please contact us for other available services.
- **Cost:** The reduced cost for the procedure will be \$60 per cat neuter and \$90 per cat spay. **Payment is due at time of intake.** Additional donations are welcome and will help us continue offering community events in the future.
- **What is included:** Spay or neuter, ear tipping, rabies vaccine, flea/tick treatment and deworming, pain medication for the day of surgery.

- **Safety Measures:** While maintaining high standards of care, this low-cost program will forgo certain procedures such as IV catheter placement and pre-anesthetic bloodwork to keep costs low. This can introduce a higher risk compared to standard surgeries where these additional safety measures are performed.
- **PetMed Animal Health Center reserves the right to decline any patient for this event for patient or human health and safety reasons.**
